<u>1 Corinthians 10:12-13</u> - If you think you are standing strong, be careful not to fall. ¹³ The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you can endure.

God's People Have A Tendency To Forget His Blessings

<u>Mark 8:18, 21</u> - 'You have eyes—can't you see? You have ears—can't you hear?' Don't you remember anything at all?...²¹ "Don't you understand yet?" he asked them.

We Don't Always Understand Christ's Purpose For Us As Quickly As We Should

Mark 8:22-26 - When they arrived at Bethsaida, some people brought a blind man to Jesus, and they begged him to touch the man and heal him. ²³ Jesus took the blind man by the hand and led him out of the village. Then, spitting on the man's eyes, he laid his hands on him and asked, "Can you see anything now?" ²⁴ The man looked around. "Yes," he said, "I see people, but I can't see them very clearly. They look like trees walking around." ²⁵ Then Jesus placed his hands on the man's eyes again, and his eyes were opened. His sight was completely restored, and he could see everything clearly. ²⁶ Jesus sent him away, saying, "Don't go back into the village on your way home."

<u>Mark 8:27-30</u> - Jesus and his disciples left Galilee and went up to the villages near Caesarea Philippi. As they were walking along, he asked them, "Who do people say I am?" ²⁸ "Well," they replied, "some say John the

Baptist, some say Elijah, and others say you are one of the other prophets." ²⁹ Then he asked them, "But who do you say I am?" Peter replied, "You are the Messiah." ³⁰ But Jesus warned them not to tell anyone about him.

A Confession Of Lordship, Death And Resurrection

<u>John 8:21, 24</u> - Later Jesus said to them again, "I am going away. You will search for me but will die in your sin. You cannot come where I am going..." ²⁴ That is why I said that you will die in your sins; for unless you believe that I Am who I claim to be, you will die in your sins."
