<u>Galatians 1:15-16</u> - But even before I was born, God chose me and called me by his marvelous grace. Then it pleased him 16 to reveal his Son to me so that I would proclaim the Good News about Jesus to the Gentiles...

<u>Galatians 6:14</u> - But as for me, may I never boast, except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

Saul's Heart And Life Was Affected By Just One Encounter With Jesus

Suffering With, And For, Jesus Was Worth More Than Anything He Could Ever Be

Philippians 3:7-11 - I once thought these things were valuable, but now I consider them worthless because of what Christ has done. ⁸ Yes, everything else is worthless when compared with the infinite value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I could gain Christ ⁹ and become one with him. I no longer count on my own righteousness through obeying the law; rather, I become righteous through faith in Christ. For God's way of making us right with himself depends on faith. ¹⁰ I want to know Christ and experience the mighty power that raised him from the dead. I want to suffer with him, sharing in his death, ¹¹ so that one way or another I will experience the resurrection from the dead!

Paul Knew That He Would Suffer For Jesus' Sake

Romans 8:18 - Yet what we suffer now is nothing compared to the glory he will reveal to us later.

One Cares More About What God Wants Than What The Self Wants

<u>Acts 8:3</u> - But Saul was going everywhere to destroy the church. He went from house to house, dragging out both men and women to throw them into prison.

<u>Acts 26:10</u> - ...I caused many believers there to be sent to prison. And I cast my vote against them when they were condemned to death.
