Habits: Routines of an Ordered Life

2 Chronicles 20:31-33 - *So Jehoshaphat ruled over the land of Judah. He was thirty-five years old when he became king, and he reigned in Jerusalem twenty-five years. His mother was Azubah, the daughter of Shilhi. ³² Jehoshaphat was a good king, following the ways of his father, Asa. He did what was pleasing in the Lord's sight. ³³ During his reign, however, he failed to remove all the pagan shrines, and the people never fully committed themselves to follow the God of their ancestors.*
